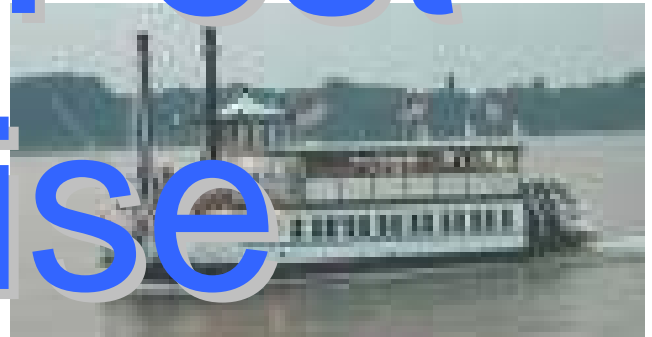

Location/Directions - Harmony Hall Regional Center is located in Southern Prince George's County within the Broad Creek Historic District, just off of Indian Head Highway. It is not accessible by public transportation.

From the Capital Beltway (I-495), take Exit 3A (Indian Head Highway) South. Follow Indian Head Highway (Route 210) South for approx four miles and make a right onto Fort Washington Rd. Make next right turn onto Livingston Road. The center is on the left.
